About APPS

Building upon the Fundamentals of Hospice Palliative Care Program, this eight-week APPS course focuses on the PSWs scope of practice as it relates to the foundational concepts of Hospice Palliative Care. Participants will learn skills to enhance communication with the person, family, and team members, develop skills required for effective team functioning and self-care, and learn strategies for relieving common endof-life symptoms.
